

# THE NATIONAL MUSIC CAMP AT AGE 60:

## A Retrospective Look at its Trombone Teachers and Students From 1928-1988

**T**he National Music Camp at Interlochen, Michigan is the oldest and most widely known fine arts training camp for gifted, talented and creative young people. Founded in 1928 by the pioneering music educator Joseph E. Maddy, first as the National High School Orchestra Camp, it later was expanded to include all forms of music, theatre, dance and visual arts. Some 2400 students ranging in age from 8 through university age come to Interlochen from every state and nearly 30 foreign countries for the eight-week summer program.

The authors, as current and former trombone teachers at National Music Camp, and in celebration of the 60th season, thought it most appropriate to the trombone community to research and publish a list of teachers and *selected* students who have contributed their time and talents to the distinguished 60-year history of Interlochen.


Since the importance of summer music camps to the future career development of young trombonists (and teachers) is

The authors apologize in advance for student names not included on the list and would be most appreciative in knowing of omissions and errors that may exist in our listings.




